## **Bellville Hebrew Nursery School in the 1950s**

Attached to the Communal Hall of the Bellville Community, at the far end, was a kitchen and a room. This room was used as a nursery school in the mornings and for *cheder* (Hebrew School) in the afternoons. It looked out onto a playground.



The first nursery-school teacher was an Israeli by the name of Sara. She introduced the children to the chagim (the Jewish Holidays) and Jewish traditions. Along with Sara, Bella Levine also taught there. Mickey Spiro used to help occasionally.

The playground had, of course, the usual things found there such as swings, slide, Jungle Jim, sandpit etc. However, there was one addition, in the late 1950s, which proved very popular, especially amongst the boys. That was a Vanguard motor car which was given to the nursery school by Bobby Goodleser who had a used car lot.

Fridays were special days at nursery school. There was a 'main' table that had candles. One or two of the children were chosen to sit at the table and say the *brachot* (blessings). There were children who did not like to be chosen, for the simple reason that they were each given a very small wine glass filled with grape juice. The other children were given much bigger glasses of the juice!


## In the box!
