

#### INDIAN NATIONAL : PIND.

Under the distinguished leadership of Colonel F.H. Kisch the Jewish National Fund Campaign is now in full swing throughout the Country. The Colonel has made his appeal to the local community and it now remains for the Maitland Youth to do their bit.

The objects of the Jewish National Fund

1. To acquire land in Eretz Yisrael with the voluntary contributions of the Jewish people, such land to be the inalienable property of the Jewish people.

2. To lease the land exclusively on hereditary leasehold for cultivation or building

thereon.

- 3. To facilitate the settlement of working farmers.
- 4. To ensure the right use of the soil,
- To combat speculation in land values.
   To ensure the cultivation of land by Jews.

That is what the fund is and stands for.

During the past 36 months of terrorism in Eretz Yisrael, 36 new settlements have been established. This means one new outpost of Zionism for every month. Thus undismayed, we continue our triumphant upbuilding of the Jewish National Home, and every new dunam of

land that the Jewish National Fund acquires strengthens, entrenches and extends the political and economic position of Jewish Palestine.

Fund that you will shortly be asked to contribute. The J.N.F. is playing an outstanding role in the redemption of the soil in Eretz Yisrael. Today; more than ever, will you in this trying hour, give the Jewish National Fund the means to acquire more and more land?

#### A REPLY TO MR. MAX BLEDIN.

Last month in a letter to this paper Mr. Max Bledin saw fit to take to task the Jewish Nation for wasting time, money, and energy on 'a spot in the East'. "It would be a far saner policy, to fight Facism and to assist other minority sections", said Mr. Bledin.

If he had only realised the difference between Zionism and Territorialism, he might have written something more constructive in outlook and more authentic in facts. The simple case which makes Mr. Bledin's argument pointless is that we Zionists are not out to save our bodies but to preserve our souls.

The Jews regard themselves and are recognised by others as a people. They have a common language, a national History, an ancient and modern culture, which represents their national aspirations and traditions and a national religion. The only thing which they require to raise them to full national status is the return of their ancient homeland in which they could develop the ideas and civilization of Israel on the land of Israel.

The realisation of this ideal does not depend on the presence or absence of antisemitism. It makes little difference whether the nations amongst which we live persecute us or not - the necessity for a Jewish Homeland remains unaffected. The urgent need from a humanitarian point of view becomes particularly more marked only in days of persecution, but the desire of Zionists for the "spot in the East" in which to preserve the soul and not necessarily to save the body of the Jew remain unchanged throughout the ages.

Anti-semitism did not originate with the rise of Fascier and will not end with its destruction. Only the restoration of the Jews as a power in Eretz Yisrael, which will enable them to live a normal life, both spiritually and politically, will solve the Jewish Problem.

And if you think that you're immune, Think back of that fateful 10th. of June.




